There will also be areas for MOSES print resources, the MOSES bookstore, and space for the MOSES library featuring its collection of books on all aspects of organic and sustainable farming and current issues related to agriculture.

MOSES is a non-profit organization working to promote sustainable and organic agriculture through trainings, workshops, educational initiatives, and by providing free resources to farmers striving to produce high-quality, healthful food using organic and sustainable techniques. In addition to trainings, field days and free resources, MOSES also organizes the Organic Farming Conference, the largest in the country, held every year in La Crosse, WI.

MOSES is having an open house on Tuesday, May 19, from 4 pm to 7 pm in their new office at S233 McKay Avenue, in Spring Valley.
